The 2004 Convention has ended and all indications are that North Dakota coaches are very satisfied with the program. The paid registration was 301. The Hall of Fame and Coach of the Year Banquet served 187 people. Although the golf outing had an emergency that would allow golfers to use carts for the first nine holes, 56 golfers still competed in the scramble.

Several basketball coaches indicated that the speakers this year were outstanding, although only one college/university level speaker presented. The only sport session that was not well attended was baseball. In view of the duplication of high school coaches and legion coaches and legion district tournaments being held, baseball coaches are always pressed for attendance.

LIONS' ALL STAR BASKETBALL REPORT Terry West

I. Games

The games were held on July 20 (Bismarck) and July 21 (Fargo). Attendance was to be good at both sites. The Class "A" All-stars won all four games.

We received several compliments from parents and players on the events and all the comments were very positive.

II. Problems

Situation 1- Should a girl that gives birth be allowed to participate?

Resolution: The coaches need to wait until the final team is set before any announcement is made to the player or parents. This would solve any problems with disqualifying a player from the team.

Situation 2- Not enough alternates for the Class B. None of the alternates accepted, leaving the Class B boys with no one to replace an injured player.

Resolution: Coaches in each region should have the next player ready for the coaches of the all-star games so that another player could be selected if needed.

Situation 3- Coaches need to be more active in making sure players are responding to information letters.

Resolution: Coaches said they would try to be more helpful if needed.

Situation 4- Should practice sites be alternated on a two-year basis?

Resolution: Felt that the Lion's Club should invite who they want to their city for practices. If they choose to alternate, that would be their choice.

Situation 5- Having the NDHSCA Convention at the same time as the all-star games.

Resolution: This may or may not be looked at in the future. However, the Lions will set the dates according to their needs and the convention would move to a week earlier if it would help attendance at both events.



Please help the NDHSCA keep your records current. Each coach must send their record at the completion of each season. If coaching more than one sport, complete each sport on a separate form. If you are completing the victory milestone for the first time, make sure to give your record for each year.



Report only the highest level of coaching each season. Don't add coaching seasons together (ex. if a coach is coaching both jr. high boys basketball and varsity basketball, count only the varsity basketball record for that season). If coaching both varsity girls' and varsity boys' basketball, count each season on separate forms and don't add together as one record. Under the new format for counting victories in certain sports such as track and field, cross country, tennis, golf, swimming, and gymnastics; the old records will need to be updated. Remember to keep each sport season separate and always report the highest level of coaching in each sport.

Procedure For Determining Won/Loss Records In An Invitational Meet:

- A. In an invitational meet, the teams that finish below you will count as victories, those that finish above you are losses. Any teams that you tie will count as a win.
- B. Figure out the total number of teams you have competed against and what percentage of those teams were wins and losses.
- C. Take the percentage of wins/losses from above and multiply it against the number of meets you participated in to arrive at your won/loss record for the season.
- D. If this is not a whole number, victories will always be rounded down and losses will be rounded up. (Obviously, if your team has participated in ten meets during the year, your wins plus losses should equal ten.)

- Schools can still have a dual meet record that would remain the same along with a record for the invitationals they attend.
- It will be up to the individual coaches to determine their records from past years and update wins or revise their victory milestone forms.
