


#### From Executive Secretary's Desk

They have amazing purchasing power since they order in such huge numbers. Check out their website, on the NHSACA Website: www.njpacoop.org/home.



#### **NDHSCA Victory Milestones**

Please help the NDHSCA keep your records current. Each coach must send their record at the completion of each season. If coaching more than one sport, complete each sport on a separate form. If you are completing the victory

milestones for the first time, make sure to give your record for each year. Report only the highest level of coaching each season. Don't add coaching seasons together (ex. if a coach is coaching both JHS boys basketball and varsity basketball, the coach counts only the varsity basketball record for that season). If coaching both varsity girls' and varsity boys' basketball, count each season on separate forms and don't add together as one record. Under the new format for counting victories in certain sports such as track and field, cross country, tennis, golf, swimming, and gymnastics; the old records will need to be updated. #### Procedure For Determining Won/Loss Records In An Invitational Meet:

- 1. In an invitational meet, the teams that finish below you will count as victories, those that finish above you are losses. Any teams that you tie will count as a win.
- 2. Figure out the total number of teams you have competed against and what percentage of those teams were wins and losses.
- 3. Take the percentage of wins/losses from above and multiply it against the number of meets you participated in to arrive at your won/loss record for the season.
- 4. If this is not a whole number, victories will always be rounded down and losses will be rounded up. (Obviously, if your team has participated in ten meets during the year, your wins plus losses should equal ten.)

-boys' basketball, football and track & field, at Fertile (MN) High School---boys' basketball, track & field and athletic director, Fessenden High School--boys' basketball, track & field, and athletic director and Larimore High School---boys' basketball, track & field and golf.

Fruhwirth coached boys' basketball teams to eleven conference Titles: eleven district Titles; two Region Runner-up Titles; seven Regional Championship Titles; one State Runner-up Title at Larimore High School (1975) and one State Championship Title at Larimore High School (1978). Bill also coached his track and field teams to five conference Titles while his Larimore High School golf team won a Regional Title and a State Runnerup Title in 1978. Fruhwirth mentored his teams to 10 victories in baseball, 351 victories in boys' basketball, 22 victories in golf, and 30 victories in track & field meets.

Coach Fruhwirth has been a model for coaches to emulate in his professional high school athletic and coaching service. He served a district chairman while at Flaxton (1960-1963) and district co-chairman while at Parshall (1965-1969). **Rich** has a gaudy 274 victories with his varsity boys' basketball teams. His total victory ladder includes 602 basketball wins and 405 baseball wins (in 15 years). At Fargo Agassiz Junior High School and Discovery Junior High School, Raasch's teams held a 328-46 record.

Raasch was a huddle leader of Fellowship of Christian Athletes. He served as a selection committee member for UPI for six years. He was a member of National Association of Basketball Coaches. He was chair and secretary of the Northeast Iowa Coaches' Association and a member of the Iowa Coaches Association for 21 years. Rich was on the Iowa All Star Selection Committee for 13 years. He was Northeast Iowa basketball coach of the year in 1970 and 1986. He has always served as his church youth group advisor in every community where he has coached.

**Rich Raasch** was nominated for the NDHSCA Hall of Fame by Gelaine Orvik.

**Rich** and his deceased wife, Connie, have two children: Brett and Kayla.

Curt Sherbrooke is a native Minnesotan where he graduated from Audubon (MN) High School and Minnesota State University in Moorhead. He coached boys' track and field, girls' gymnastics and volleyball at Hawley High School for three years. He moved on to coach girls' gym-

nastics at Fargo South High School in 1981-1982. After coaching girls' gymnastics for one year at Bismarck St. Mary's High School, Curt became head girls' gymnastics coach for Bismarck High School and Bismarck Century High School (1982-present).

Sherbrooke coached his gymnastics teams to West Region Runnerup Titles on twelve occasions and West Region Championships six times. Century High School has earned five State Gymnastics Runnerup Titles, while Bismarck High School has won three Runnerup Titles.
