




NDHSCA Scholarships Sponsored by Burger King of North Dakota


Carly earned 12 athletic letters in the sports of basketball, softball, track and field and volleyball.




Christine Retzlaff is from Wahpeton HS and plans to attend Northern State University at Aberdeen or St. Cloud State University.
